

How to Install Vinyl Lettering

“Tools” needed:

- Mild soap and water (works great in a spray bottle!) or windex.
- Masking tape
- Plastic squeegee or a credit card
- Lint free or microfiber cloth



1. Clean your surface with mild soap and water.

I recommend Turtle Wax label and sticker remover to remove residue or gum.

2. Wipe with a clean lint free cloth (you can get microfiber cloth at a Hardware Store or Walmart)

3. Make a hinge with masking tape for the sign you want to apply.

4. Place the lettering on the surface.

5. Lift The Sign Upwards**

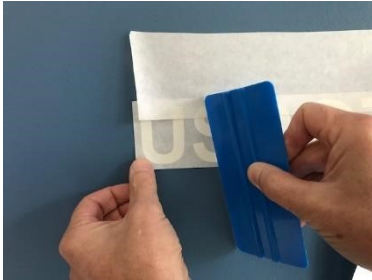

Remove the backing.

7. Transfer The Vinyl to the surface.
8. Apply the lettering with a plastic squeegee or credit card.



****The wet install method helps to minimize bubbles.** After placing the lettering with the masking tape hinge, lightly wet the surface where the vinyl will be affixed.
